



## 2023 FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES

\*The 2023 Federal Poverty Guidelines apply to all states and for the District of Columbia (except Alaska and Hawaii)

Family Size	Federal Poverty Guideline (FPG)	If income is below 200% (shown below) of FPG→ eligible for <u>Full</u> Financial Assistance	If income is above 200% but below 400% (shown below) of FPG→ eligible for <u>Partial</u> Financial Assistance
1	\$14,580	\$29,160	\$58,320
2	\$19,720	\$39,440	\$78,880
3	\$24,860	\$49,720	\$99,440
4	\$30,000	\$60,000	\$120,000
5	\$35,140	\$70,280	\$140,560
6	\$40,280	\$80,560	\$161,120
7	\$45,420	\$90,840	\$181,680
8	\$50,560	\$101,120	\$202,240

For family units of more than 8 members, add \$5,140 for each additional member.

The Federal Poverty Guidelines document will be updated annually.
