Through a comprehensive community health needs assessment conducted in 2021, it became clear that accessible outpatient health care services were urgently needed in east Broward County for adults and children. Services at the Holy Cross Health Family Health Center will include primary care, annual wellness check-ups, immunizations, social services, pediatric therapy, community education and support, laboratory services, medical nutrition therapy, and culinary medicine.

"The Holy Cross Health Family Health Center represents our commitment to improving health-care accessibility and care for the common good," said Kim Saiswick, VP of Community Health and Well-being. "It will make a tangible difference in the lives of countless individuals, providing them with the care and resources they need to lead

Spanning 15,000 square feet, the facility is located on the first floor of the Holy Cross Medical

Plaza at 5601 N. Dixie Hwy. in Oakland Park and is the only healthcare facility in eastern and northern Broward County to provide pediatric occupational therapy, physical therapy and speech language therapy under one roof. The office features a low stimulation room for pediatric patients with sensory sensitivities, such as individuals on the autism spectrum. Feeding therapy is available for infants and toddlers who have trouble swallowing and patients can learn how to feed themselves using adaptive utensils.

In addition to health care services, the Family Health Center will also host workshops on resume writing, interviewing skills labs, personal finance and budgeting to assist adults with gaining employment and self-sufficiency.

"The Holy Cross Health Family Health Center will provide a warm, welcoming atmosphere," Saiswick added. "Our focus is to meet the present and future healthcare needs of our community while being at the forefront of innovation."

#### Holy Cross Health receives grant for HIV/AIDS care

Holy Cross Health has received a three-year grant from ViV Positive Action Network to develop a support network for peers and professionals providing social services to people living with HIV/AIDS. Rotato remains one of the highest states in the nation to report new cases of HIV and syphilis.

As cases continue to soor, the Holy Cross Health Community Health and Well-Baing Department continues its efforts to respond. Many individuals into themselves having to learn to navigate the complex and changing health-care system. The Navigator Network, newly hinded by VilV, will offer quarterly in-person and monthly online meetings with the goal of bringing case managers, peers, community health workers, and other client-facing specialists together to discuss resources, challenges, and positive outcomes.
